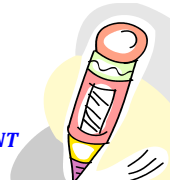

CONSECRATION CROSSES

Last Wednesday, the feast of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas Moore, our 12 brass consecration crosses were installed around the walls of the Church ready for the consecration of the Church, which will take place in a few months time once the Church has been decorated and the stained glass restored. Together with the consecration of the five crosses on the altar and the placing of relics of a martyr under the altar, the consecration of the 12 crosses around the Church form the principle act of dedicating a Church to the worship of Almighty God. The five crosses on the altar represent the five wounds of Our Lord; the twelve consecration crosses represent the Apostles. The sconces, candle/holder placed beneath the consecration crosses, are modelled on the big six on the High Altar.

The crosses and sconces were hand made by one of our parishioners, Mr. John Ferrier. As well as being a devout Catholic, John is a highly skilled craftsman. The crosses are based on those found in the circular stained glass windows. The red in the cross represents martyrdom - like the Apostles we too are called to witness with our lives. The brass circular disk reminds us that as we go through life Christ is always with us in the Holy Eucharist. In the cross of Christ we find meaning and purpose for our own suffering.
